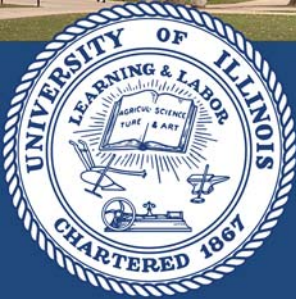




Faculty Development in Higher Education
