Credit Transferability

The transferability of credits gained at the Winter and Summer University of HU is determined by the students' home university. Students should consult their home university about credit transferability before registration.

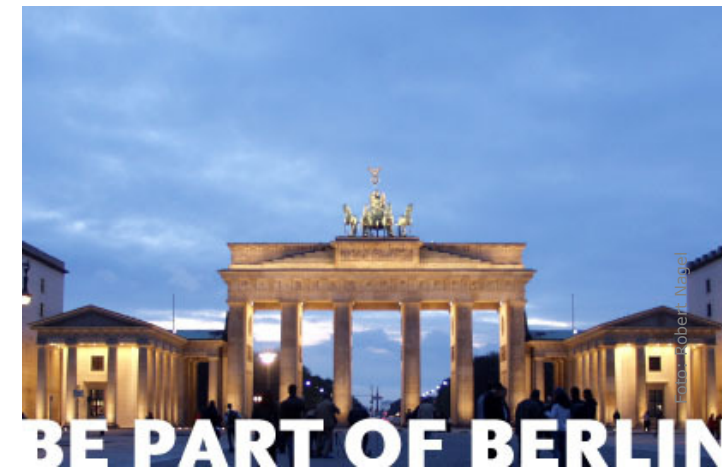
