## Japanese Winter Program

### You will experience Japan next winter!



Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU) offers a 4-week winter Japanese course in 2016. The program aims at providing a comprehensive introduction to Japanese language and culture.

Students will develop their language skills, experience traditional Japanese culture such as classic tea ceremony, and increase their understanding of the Japanese society through field studies.

#### Program Contents

The 4-week program consists of 60 hours of Japanese language study, field trips, and 18 hours of Japan Studies. Students will be evaluated according to class participation, oral presentation and weekly quizzes. A certificate will be issued upon completion of the program.

#### ■ Japanese Language + Field Trips

The Japanese language class, Intermediate, is designed for students who want to accelerate their language skills in the intensive program.

#### ◇ Intermediate Class:

This class aims to develop mainly the proficiency in speaking for daily conversation in Japanese at intermediate level (CERF: A2 or higher). The participants of this class are required to have completed the basic level Japanese course (CERF: A1).

#### ■ Japan Studies

A variety of issues regarding contemporary Tokyo and Japan will be studied inside and outside of the classroom.

#### Fee

115,000.00- JPY

Tuition fee is waived according to the exchange agreement. This program cost includes accommodation fee, and education materials. Not included in the program fee are meals, airfare, travel insurance, field-trips, transportation between the University and accommodation, and daily expenses. All fees should be paid by overseas remittance no later than November 10. Details regarding the payment method will be sent after your application is accepted.

\*Your passport's expiration date must be no shorter than 6 months prior to the end end of the program.

#### Cancelation Policy

Please be advised that once your application has been accepted and you have paid the fee, the following cancellation policy will apply:

Maximum 50% of the program fee will be forfeited in case of cancellation **on and before November 30.**

Maximum 100% of the program fee will be forfeited in case of cancellation **on and after December 1.**

The cancellation policy applies for any reasons. Any handling or service fees incurred for refunding the fee will be borne by the applicant. It will take two to three months to reimburse the program fee.

- ✧ For some winter programs, admission could be competitive and not all applicants are admitted due to the limited capacity of the program.
- ✧ The program schedule may be subject to change.
- ✧ Participants in the program are required to purchase traveler's insurance to cover medical costs incurred during the period of the stay in Japan at their own expense. Please submit the copy of insurance certificate before arrival.
