Special Cultural Excursion Trip

Current undergraduate and graduate students including prospective students who will begin undergraduate studies in Fall 2017

Required Materials

Applications are accepted online only. Students must submit the following:

- face picture (3cm x 4cm) in jpg file format
- scanned copy of college or university enrollment or transcript
- scanned copy of passport bio-page
- scanned copy of overseas traveler's insurance

3. Ewha ISC sends a letter of acceptance via e-mail
4. Pay the tuition
